The problem of soil erosion is of major significance in various countries and especially in many parts of India. Soil erosion occurs in successive steps, the earliest of which may easily pass unnoticed. In the later stages, the cutting up and washing away of the earth is only too painfully apparent in the formation of deep make which ravines and gullies agriculture impossible. Sudden bursts of excessively heavy rain resulting in a large run of surplus water are the principal factors in causing soil erosion. The slope of the land, removal of the natural protective coat of vegetation, the existences of ruts along which water can flow rapidly gathering momentum, and the absence of any checks of such flow are also causes for soil erosion.
